

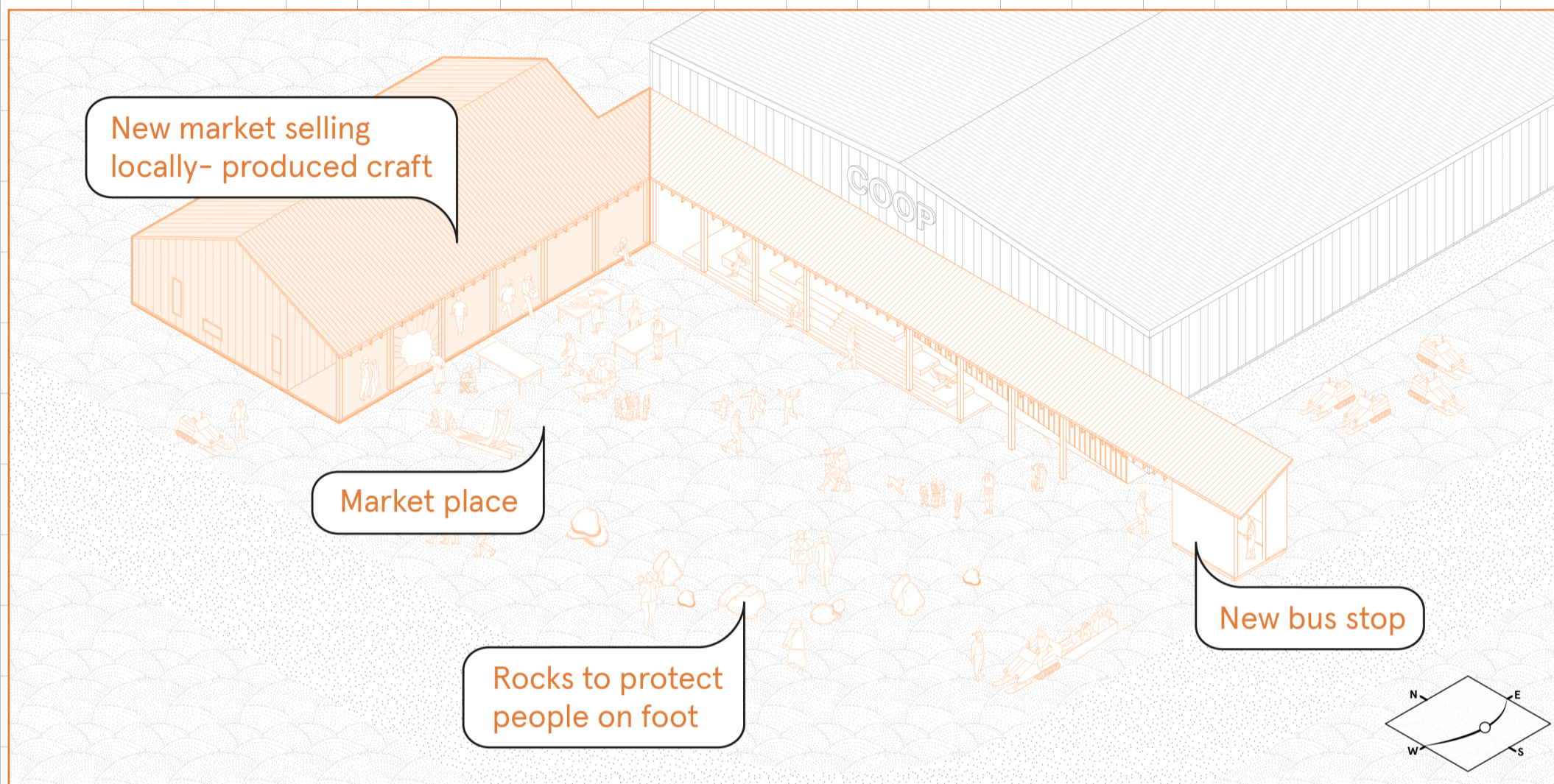

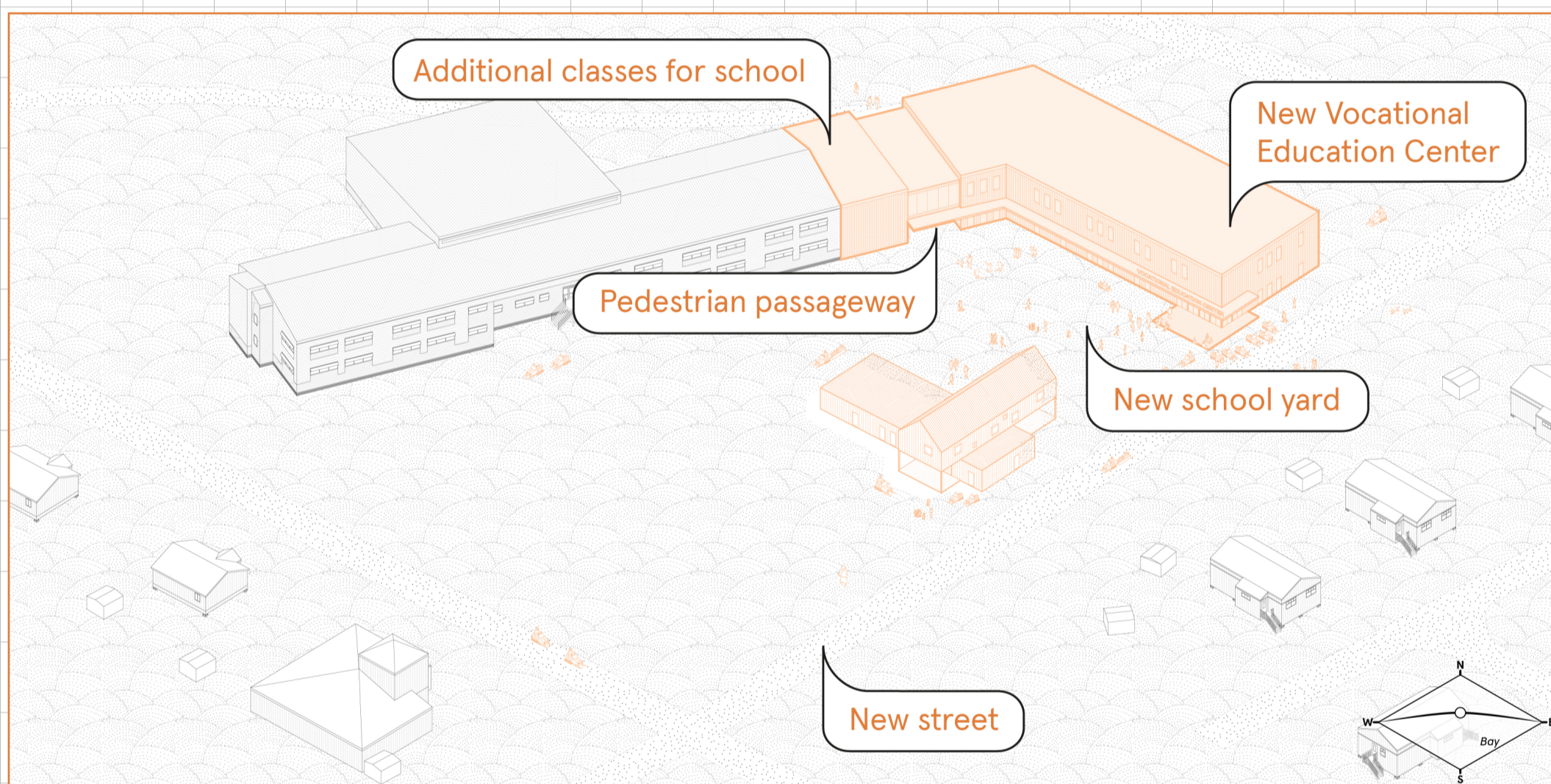
MEANS OF ACTION

VILLAGE CENTER

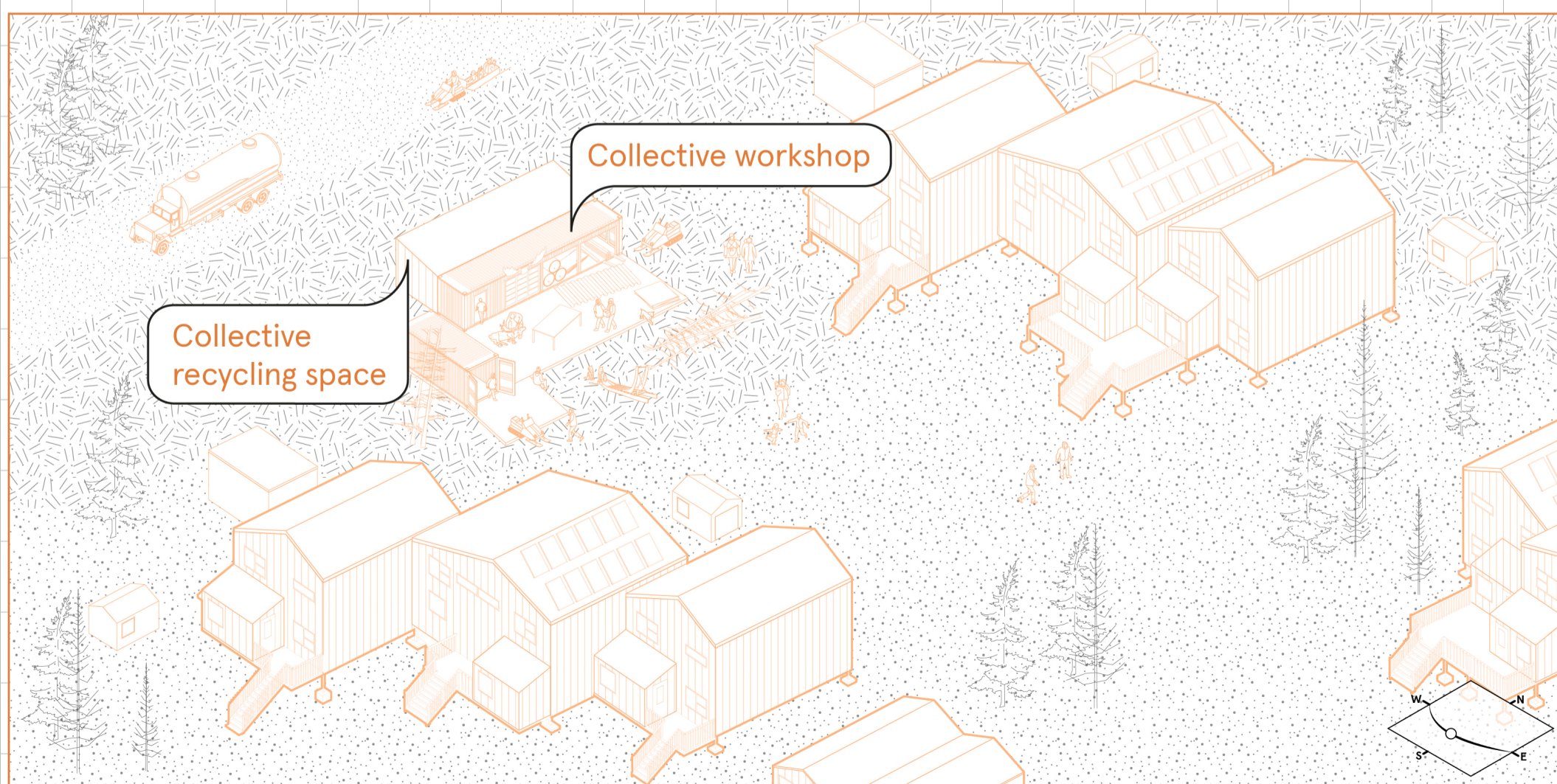
The Coop Store is extended to include a new market which offers locally-sourced goods, crafts, foods or services. When weather permits, outside stalls are added. This enhanced community space brings together Kangiqsualujjuamiut and add opportunities for share in traditional activities and know-how or exchange in a comfortable and friendly setting.



RESIDENTIAL AREA

The new Vocational Center is a place of learning where students develop their abilities in certain professions or trade. This is an added opportunity for youths, outside or in complement to the current school system.

For instance, knowledge about construction and the recycling of certain materials could be acquired and tested in well-equipped workshops. Such training could inspire local experts to take part in shaping Kangiqsualujjuaq's built environment and economy.



NEW DEVELOPMENT

To promote the reuse of materials, new development areas will include collective recycling spaces and workshops. Crafty, ingenious residents exercise their abilities close to home while unwanted materials or used parts are given a new purpose.

These workshops promote knowledge sharing in the fields of construction and in the arts and crafts. Innovative products or know-how are also translated into new economic opportunities.
